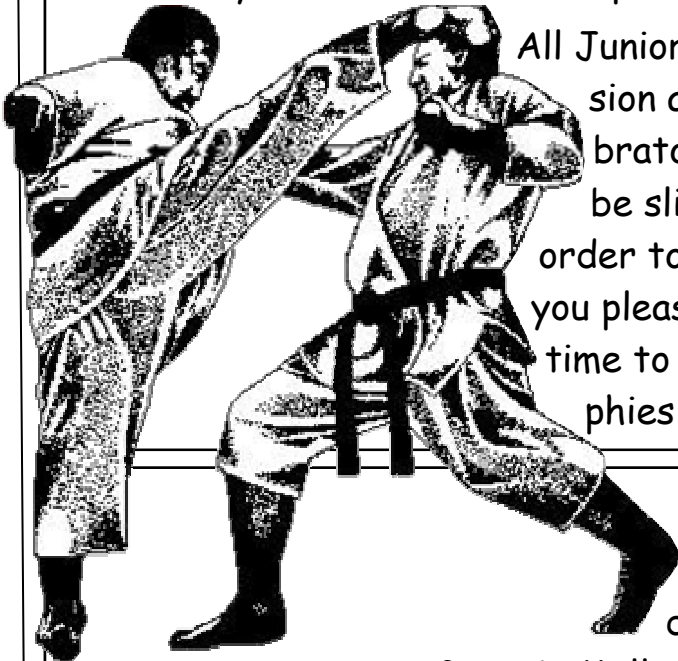

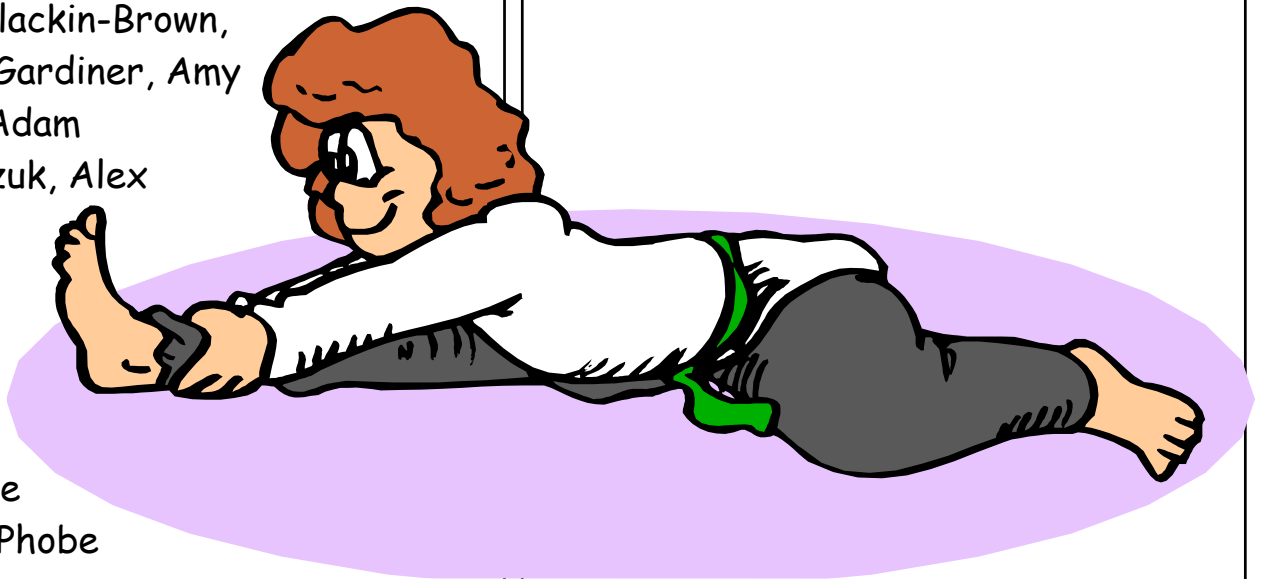
## September Students of the Month
