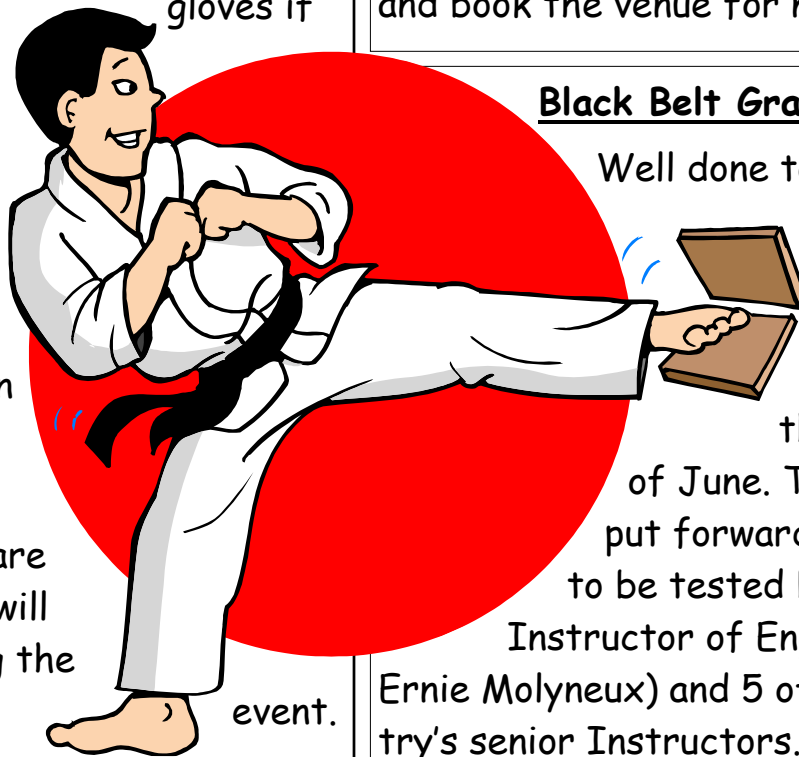
July Grading

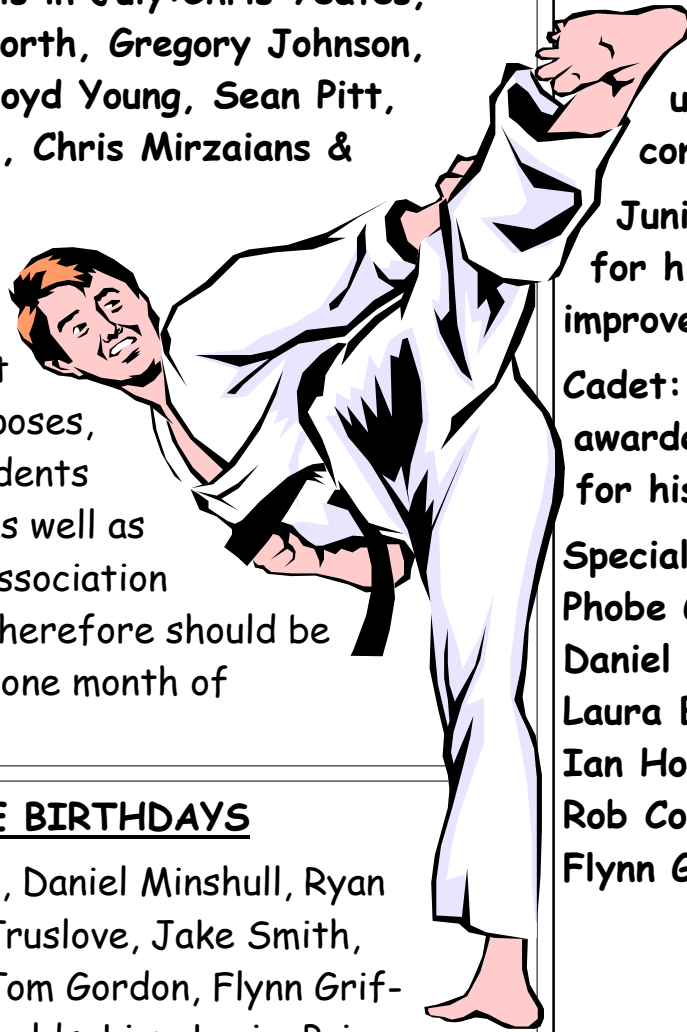
