If you wish to take photographs this is allowed but will be confirmed on the day. Any parents objecting to this should express their views beforehand.

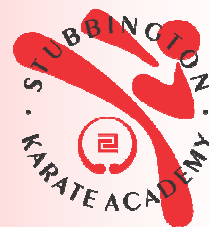
The grading will begin at 9am sharp so please arrive early for registration. I look forward to seeing you all there.
