Grading will commence at 12.00pm and finish at 5.00pm.


Junior training fees for the whole weekend are £17.50. We also have 6 students from the Academy who hope to be testing so support from fellow students would be appreciated no doubt.

**Junior:** Oliver White has the trophy this month for his continued efforts with his Kihon

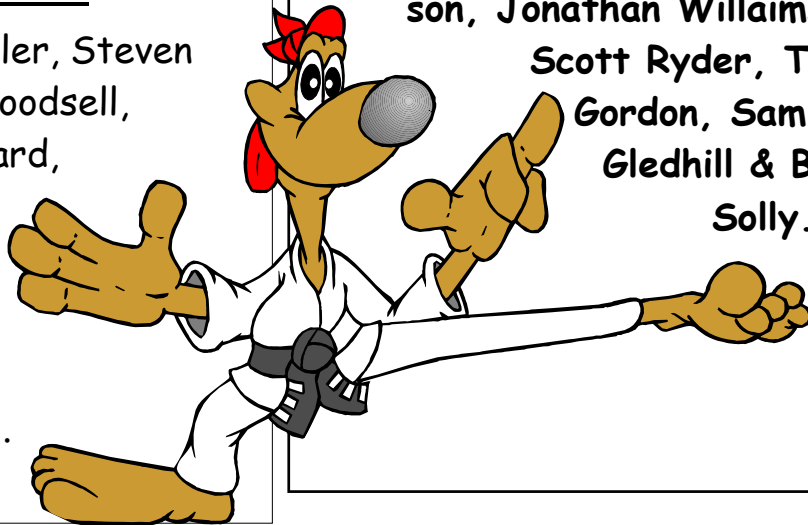
