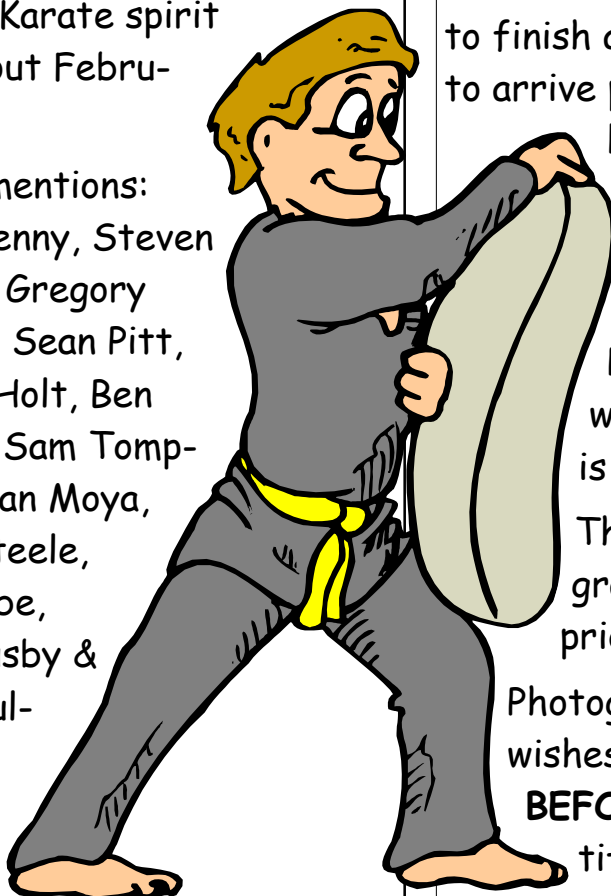
## Students of the Month

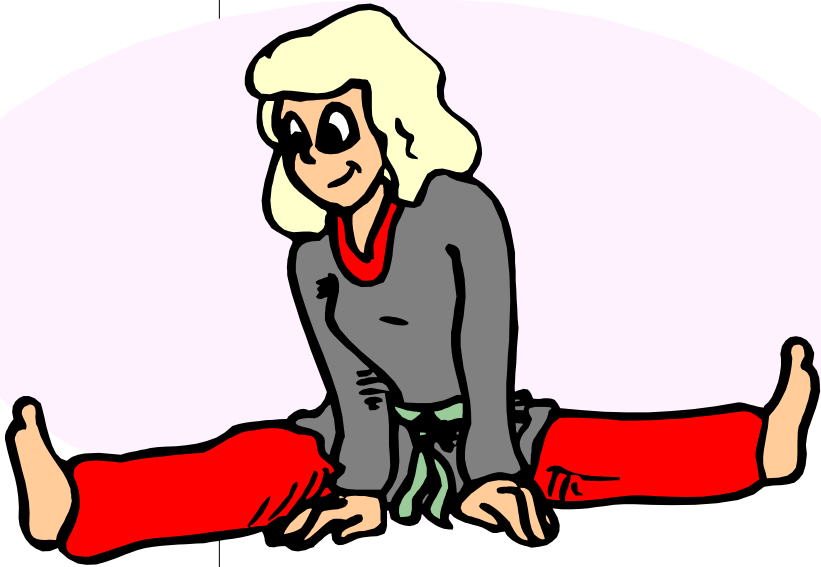
## License Renewals
