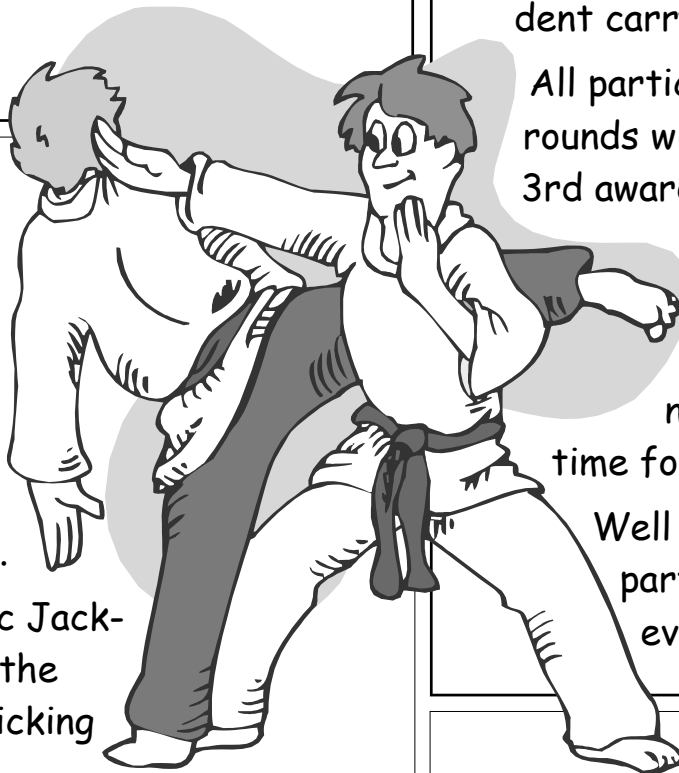
All participants had at least 3 rounds with placings for 1st, 2nd & 3rd awarded.
