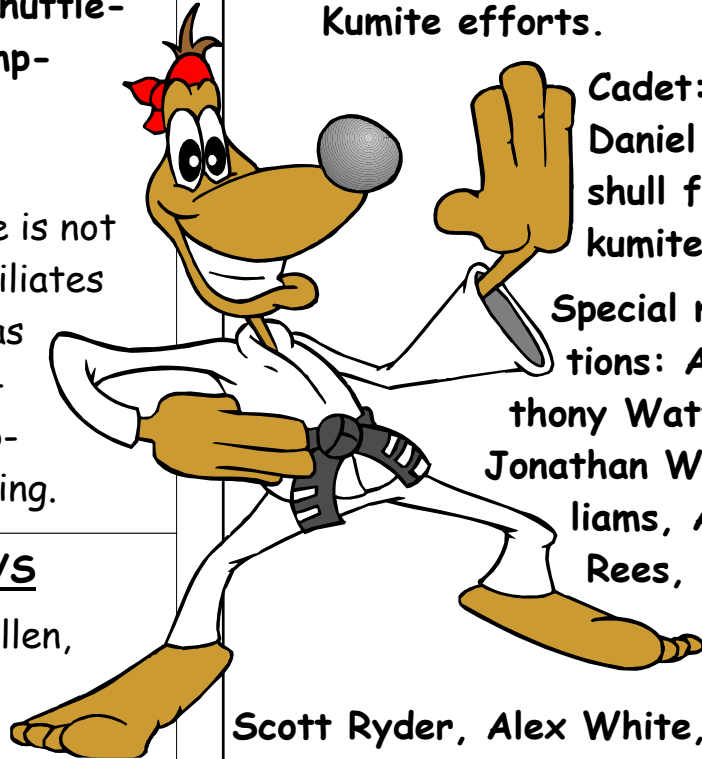
License Renewals
